Update: September 26, 2020

Church Family,

Adapting:

- Tithe and Offering collection boxes will be located near the entrance and exit of the gym.
- The school portion of the Family Life Center will not be open during the worship experiences.
- A digital bulletin will replace the paper bulletin.
- The speaker will usher out the audience at the end of each service.
- All worship team members will use the stage to maintain the physical distancing protection of the congregation.
- Sabbath School classes will not resume indoors on campus at this time.

Guidelines:

- Physical distancing of at least 6ft. between family groups is expected at all times. We discourage handshakes and hugs at this time. Waves and air hugs are great!
- Masks are required while inside the building and recommended while on the campus. (When someone is speaking or singing on stage as part of the worship team, he or she may remove his or her mask while on stage). If you forget your mask, single use masks will be available at the entrance to the building.
- Regular handwashing and sanitizing of hands are encouraged.
- Congregating before or after worship experiences is strongly discouraged in all buildings.
- If someone has been infected by the Covid virus, it is required he or she has been cleared by a doctor prior to returning to an in-person worship experience at PTC SDA Church.
- If someone has been in direct contact with a person infected by the Covid virus without wearing full hospital PPE, watching PTC SDA Church online service is strongly encouraged for two weeks prior to returning to in-person worship experiences.
